## 2015-073 **RECOGNITIONS**

- Congratulations to the SSHS Archery Team who placed 6<sup>th</sup> out of 39 high schools in the Indiana NASP State Tournament on Saturday March 14<sup>th</sup>. The team scored their highest team score ever with a score of 3263. A HUGE congratulation to Taylor Vanover who placed 3<sup>rd</sup> out of 349 high school males. He also placed 4<sup>th</sup> overall out of 1058 males in the state. Taylor had two rounds of 50 from the 10 meter line and finished with a score of 289, tying his personal best. Tyler Mallory, Corinne Zimmerman, and Makayla Johansen also scored personal bests at the State Tournament. They have qualified for Nationals which will be held in Louisville in May. This is the second year for the Archery team, last year they qualified for State where they placed 18<sup>th</sup> out of 30 high schools.
- South Spencer County School Corporation received again for the 2014-2015 school year an outstanding award in regards to our music education by being named a "Best Community for Music Education" by the National Association of Music Merchants (NAMM). Only 7 school districts were recognized in the state of Indiana and 388 nationally.
